FY 2019 Proposed Budget

- City Manager Submitted a Balanced Budget on August 8, 2018
 - Ending Fund Balance/Reserve for at least six months of operations
 - Current tax rate maintained
 - Balanced Budget supports exceptional City-wide service levels sustained



FY 2019 Proposed Budget

- City Council proposed two-cent tax rate increases revenue \$107,366. If Adopted
- Possible use of additional dollars:
 - Street Maintenance
 - Drainage Improvements
 - Capital Improvements



FY 2019 Proposed Budget

- Recommendation for Re-Allocation of funded expenditures (General Fund):
 - Total available funds \$331,334 to transfer to the Supplemental Streets and Drainage Fund
 - Equates to 4.8% of budget for Re-allocation
 - Re-allocation of funds have no impact on services related to Public Safety(Police, Fire and Dispatch)

Sale of 1998 E-One Truck	\$35,000
Total of Surplus to General Fund	\$346,334*
Increase of Legal Fee Line Item	-\$15,000
Recommendation for Re-Allocation to Supplemental Street Fund	\$331,334*
*Approximately 4.8% of proposed budget available for Re-Allocation
